

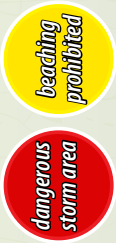


HOUSEBOAT TRAVEL TIMES FROM WATERWAY MARINA BASE TO LOCATION AT 2200 RPM

IMPORTANT!
Beaching Rule
 If you look out the back of your houseboat and see nothing but open water down the length of the arm of the lake, you are in a DANGEROUS location.

CINNEMOUSIN NARROWS PARK

- Houseboats must not be beached between the signs at Haven Point and the ranger cabin during the period of July 1st through Labour Day.
- A pump-out station is located at Cinnemousin Narrows Park where sewage pumping may be arranged for a nominal fee.
- Check posted schedule for hours of operation.
- Fireworks are prohibited in BC provincial parks.

TO ENTER AND EXIT SICAMOUS NARROWS

- Make sure you enter beneath the bridges in a straight line between the pillars. If you do not, the Houseboat can be slightly sideways between the pillars and the current will tend to push the Houseboat towards them. If the Houseboat is straight when traveling between the pillars, the driver can counteract the current by utilizing the throttle and "powering out" of any trouble.
- After driving under the railway bridge you must make a sharp turn to the left. There is a sandbar in the water just past the railway bridge which is marked by a white pillar with a green capped navigation light. You must stay BETWEEN the railroad bridge and the green and white navigation pillar to avoid the sandbar.
- Before leaving or entering the channel, you must receive approval from Waterway Base.

TO ENTER AND EXIT SALMON ARM WARE

- At low water levels (later summer and fall), please use extreme caution when entering the Salmon Arm marina as the route is quite limited and it is easy to run aground.

SOUTH to Oroville
